

## Privacy Policy

1. The Controller of users' personal data collected on the website (later on called the 'Controller') is Zdzisław Iwanejko who conducts economic activity registered under the company name Iwanejko Electronics at Gen. Andersa Street 33/195, 00-159 in Warsaw, company ID number (REGON): 012083784, VAT identification number (NIP) 526 005 16 98.
2. If the user does not agree with the website's Privacy Policy, he is kindly asked to leave the website, not to sign up for any newsletters belonging to the Controller and not to use any products or services offered by the Controller.
3. The Controller gathers users' data (on their behaviors and themselves) by:
  - getting users to voluntarily provide their data by filling in a questionnaire form;
  - using cookies
  - collecting the website server's logs through the hosting operator
4. The Controller processes users' personal data to fulfill his obligation under the contract for his products and services as well as to market his products and services.
5. The basis for processing users' personal data (by the Controller) is the consent provided by the users as well as his statutory right to process users' personal data to:
  - enable users to make use of the website's functionalities;
  - complete user's order on the Controller's products and services
  - react upon information sent by a user to the Controller through the contact form
  - deliver a free of charge newsletter upon subscription
  - market the Controller's products and services.
6. The user accepts this Privacy Policy by providing his personal data by filling in the form to set up an account, buy the Controller's product, sign up for a free of charge newsletter, or by using the contact form or by ticking the correct box.
7. The user, by providing personal data in the process of filling in the form or ticking the correct box, agrees to have his personal data processed for user's orders completion,

delivery of the products, marketing the Controller's and the Controller's partners products and services.

8. Providing personal data is voluntary. A user has the right, at any time, to access, correct or remove his personal data.

9. A user has the right to file a justified request to stop processing of his personal data if the data is processed with the objectives listed in Article 23, paragraph 1(4) and (5) in the Law on personal data protection (Ustawa o Ochronie Danych Osobowych), including marketing objectives.

10. The Controller will only process the data which are necessary to duly deliver the Controller's services as well as to use the statutory rights, including statistical objectives, in the case of complaint handling, VAT invoice issuing and redress inquiry by the Controller.

11. When a user agrees to obtain commercial offer by electronic means, the user's personal data can be processed also to send him such an offer.

12. The range of data processed includes name, surname, email address, telephone number, address. In the case of the contact form on the Controller's website, the range is limited to name and email address.

13. If the Controller finds out that a user has been using the Controller's website against the Terms of Use or against the law; the Controller will be able to process the user's personal data in order to establish user's liability.

14. In order to prevent unauthorized access or discovery of users' personal data, the Controller asserts adequate physical and electronic procedures to protect and secure the information, however even with the highest professional diligence, because of the internet's nature, the Controller cannot assert that the information will be 100% safe.

15. Signing up for a free of charge newsletter available on the handyshower.pl website and belonging to the Controller requires the user to provide his name and email address in a special questionnaire form.

16. Ordering products and services offered by the Controller via the handyshower.pl website is possible after setting up an account or, without setting up an account, through an order form available on the website. In the case of placing an order, the user needs to provide his personal data such as his name, surname, email address, telephone number, and address.

17. The data will only be used to deliver the order.

18. The Controller reserves his right to send unannounced messages to his clients who had agreed to have their personal data processed for marketing purposes of the Controller's products and services.

19. 'Unannounced messages' are to be understood as messages containing information related to the Controller's website, products and services, recommendations, commentaries, notices, etc.

20. Personal data revealed by the user in the comments section, forum, etc. on the websites belonging to the Controller, will be available to all the website's visitors.

21. The Controller cannot protect users from individuals as well as companies using personal data to send unsolicited information. The data does not fall under this Privacy Policy.

22. Privacy Policy does not apply to companies and services whose contact data are displayed on the Controller's websites and in the newsletters.

23. The Controller will not sell users' personal data to other entities.

24. The Controller can make users' personal data available to companies, collaborating with the shop, which offer post or courier services, payment services as well as other companies, provided that such an action is necessary to adequately fulfill the Controller's obligations resulting from the contract with the user. In such cases, the amount of the transferred data will be limited to the necessary minimum.

25. Users' data can be made available to entities holding the right to obtain them based on the law, including the law enforcement authorities.

26. The Controller reserves the right to change the Privacy Policy by its amendment. The user can, at any moment, check Privacy Policy on the [handyshower.pl](http://handyshower.pl) website to make sure he is happy about the changes.
